



## **COLLECTING DONATIONS FOR YOUR SPONSORED EVENT OR CHALLENGE**

There are a number of ways in which you can collect donations for your sponsored event or challenge. These are outlined below:

# **JUST GIVING Online Sponsorship Page**

We encourage all our supporters to use Just Giving, which is a free online donations page. You can create your own page, send the link to family, friends and colleagues, and then simply collect donations online. The best part is that donations will automatically be transferred to our bank account saving time and resources. Please follow the instructions below to set up your online sponsorship page:

- 1. Go to www.justgiving.com/gmiau
- 2. Click on the "Fundraise for us" button
- 3. If you already have an account, log in. If not, select "sign up" at the bottom of the page.
- 4. Click on "organised event" and then select Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit from the list of charities.
- 5. Find the event or create your own.
- 6. Personalize your page by adding your target, photo and write a message to tell everyone what you are doing and why they should sponsor you.
- 7. Be sure to write a thank you message. This will be sent to everyone who sponsors you.
- 8. Ensure that the "end date" of your page is set to be around 2 weeks after the event date.
- 9. Your fundraising page is now ready! Share the link with as many people as possible.
- 10. Ask supporters to Gift Aid their donation if they are a UK tax payers. This will make their donation worth 25% to our charity, at no cost to you or your sponsors!

#### **JUST GIVING Text Donations**

You can set up a unique text donation code and then encourage your supporters to give via mobile. To make a text donation, sponsors can simply send your 6 digit code and the donation amount to 700700. What's great is that 100% of text donations will go directly to GMIAU. Please follows the instructions below to set up your text donations:

- 1. Log in to your Just Giving account
- 2. Click on "your pages", and select the current event you're fundraising for.
- 3. Click on "get started with your unique text code".
- 4. Scroll down the page and click "personalise your code".
- 5. Choose 4 letters and 2 numbers and click the "save" button.
- 6. You are now ready to share these details with your family, friends and colleagues.



# **Paper Sponsorship Form**

If you prefer to use a paper sponsorship form or a supplement to your online page, please find form attached at the pack of this pack. The form includes a gift aid option which donors can select of eligible. Once all sponsorship money has been raised, you can use different methods to pay in the money:

Please ensure you include the sponsorship form with all the details and tell us about your amazing fundraising efforts.

You can then go to <a href="https://www.justgiving.com/gmiau">https://www.justgiving.com/gmiau</a> or directly to your Just Giving Online Sponsorship Page and make a donation with your debit/credit card.
- 3. In person: If you would like to make a donation in person, you can come by our office to drop of money raised and your sponsorship form. Please email <a href="mailto:sara@gmiau.org">sara@gmiau.org</a> to ensure we are in the office to meet you and thank you for your efforts. We would love to hear all about your event or challenge!

## **KEEPING IT LEGAL**

Before starting your fundraising for Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit, please read our Terms and Conditions below.

In raising funds for Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit, I will...

- 1. Use my best endeavours to raise money for Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit and not do anything to bring Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit into disrepute.
- 2. Obtain and submit all money raised within two months of my fundraising activity to Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit.
- 3. Get approval in advance from Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit if using logo in print or digital materials.
- 4. Ensure that all materials include 'Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit, Registered Charity: 1123908'
- 5. Obtain prior approval from Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit before approaching any companies, press or celebrities to support my event.
- 6. Sign the relevant form for the use of collection tins if required.
- 7. Not carry out house-to-house collections.
- 8. Not collect in any public place without first obtaining a collector's licence from the appropriate local authority (usually the council).
- 9. Not collect on private property (including shops, pubs etc.) without first obtaining the permission of the owner.
- 10. Not hold a raffle over more than one day without obtaining a licence from my local authority.
- 11. I shall also pass 100% of all proceeds from any permitted activity of this type solely to Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit.
- 12. Not sell alcohol at any event without having the appropriate liquor license.
- 13. Make sure my event, and any third parties involved are fully insured and not take unnecessary personal risks.
- 14. Acknowledge that Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit cannot take responsibility for any losses made through my event or liability arising from my event.
- 15. Return any unused fundraising materials that I will not require in the future to Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit.
- 16. Inform Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit at the earliest possible opportunity if I have had to cancel my event due any circumstances.
- 17. I understand that Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit may terminate my right to raise funds at any time.
- 18. I understand that all funds raised from my event will support the work of Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit, registered charity number 1123908.
- 19. I agree any information provide by me in connection with Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit events may be recorded and used by Greater Manchester Immigration Aid Unit in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.



### **FUNDRAISING SUPPORT**

We really appreciate your commitment to fundraise for our charity. Please let us know what you are planning on doing, as there are many ways in which we can help you:

- Help create promotional materials
- Promote your event to all of our supporters
- Offer ongoing support

We compiled some tips to help with your fundraising efforts prior to your sponsored event:

- 1. **Know GMIAU.** When people are asked to sponsor a charity event, they will want to know where the money is going. It is important that you know what Greater Manchester Immigration Aid does and how donations make a difference. We have a number of tools to help you share out story: case studies, quotations, annual reports and leaflets. Email us at <a href="mailto:sara@gmiau.org">sara@gmiau.org</a> to request these items.
- 2. **Use your imagination.** Try to develop unique and attractive promotions as this will entice more people to support your event. Be creative in letting people know how they can sponsor you. Perhaps they can't donate, but they may offer to help in other ways.
- 3. **Be enthusiastic.** Be confident and enthusiastic about your sponsored event. Don't be afraid to ask for donations, but don't be discouraged if not everyone you ask sponsors you. Stay positive and don't give up.
- 4. **Social media.** Be sure to share your journey on your social media networks. In addition, remember to link to our social media outlets, as it is a quick and simple way to raise awareness and promote your event. Try using Twitter, Facebook and even YouTube to create a video diary to tell your story.
- 5. **Promote.** Tell you family, friends and colleagues about your sponsored event. You can even advertise it in your staff newsletter or community centres.
- 6. **Photos.** Take lots of pictures (and videos) as your prepare for the event, but also during. Share these images with us so that can help your promote but also inspire others to participate.
- 7. **Thank everyone.** Always remember to thank people as they sponsor you. Keep them updated after the event and let them know how much you raised in total.
