What we want interpreters to think about in age assessments.



We are young people from the All4One group.

All of us are in the UK on our own, living in Greater Manchester. We have all had experience of the age assessment process. We want to make positive change and help others going through the age assessment process.

one

Make sure you speak the same dialect and we can understand each other.

two

Explain things clearly and make sure we can understand.

three

Use simple words that we can understand easily and take your time.

four

Make sure you understand what we say before interpreting.

five

Don't put pressure on us to answer if we don't know.

six

Listen and please interpret exactly what we say, nothing more, nothing less.
